ETIQUETTE AT COMMUNION: When it is time for Communion, there will only be one Priest and only one line (social distancing markers are in place) with alternating rows going up to receive. (i.e. an entire row on the right side of the Church will receive Communion followed by the entire row on the left side of the Church). Reception of Communion by hand is preferred. Those receiving Communion are instructed to remove their masks while the person ahead of them is receiving Communion. After the Priest says, "The Body of Christ" and the communicant responds "Amen" (at a distance of two meters - six feet), only then does the communicant leave the physical distance maker to approach the Priest to receive Communion. If you choose not to receive Holy Communion, you may need to leave your seat to allow social distancing for those that are exiting or entering the pew before and after Communion.
